### Job purpose

Primary care physicians are usually the first point of contact for people seeking medical care. These doctors must be able to assess, diagnose, and treat a wide range of conditions, ranging from broken bones to more exotic illnesses. Physicians often care for families across generations and are an integral part of many people's lives. In cases where more specialized medical care is needed, a family practice physician will refer their patient to another physician for more focused care.

### Duties and responsibilities

- Manages substance use disorders by offering/prescribing medications in addiction treatment (MAT) and offers transitional treatment of primary care conditions, within the scope of credentialed privileges and standardized procedures, to patients of CSC MAT Clinic, utilizing trauma-informed, motivational interviewing skills and encouraging patient activation and self-management.
- Provides or makes arrangements for preventive care and immunizations and management of patient's chronic disease.
- Works collaboratively with community partners and other CSC sites, including MAT team, outpatient treatment programs, and primary care and mental health providers.
- Provide the full spectrum of outpatient primary care for adults and children.
- Record patient history, perform or request diagnostic tests and make diagnoses.
- Prescribe appropriate treatment, administering vaccinations and performing follow-up examinations, as well as educating patients in disease prevention and health maintenance.
- Provide individual patient instruction in accordance to prescribe treatment plan.
- Prepare medical records, clinical reports and correspondences.
- Supervise allied health professionals, such as nurses, physician assistants and medical assistants as assigned.
- Attend conferences and seminars when requested and comply with continuing education requirements.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
