Job purpose

An intake counselor is responsible for completing triage and determine what services are needed collecting medical, physical, and mental history and special requirement of prospective clients. The duty includes but not limited to filling out forms, outlining reasons for seeking treatment and history of past treatment efforts, administer and score required tests, answer services offered and review program materials with clients and family members.

Duties and responsibilities

- Conduct triage assessment of potential clients, and communicate the assessment to clinicians and/or appropriate team member
- Responds to telephone inquiries, providing accurate information, complete preadmission screening and determine suitable referral
- Collect all necessary data and documentation in compliance with program
- Communicate with applicants telephonically, online (e.g. video conferencing), or inperson regarding programs offered
- Using EHR to schedule appointments, input data and documentation
- Obtains and records accurate documentation
- Complete all required documentation and reports in a timely fashion
- Maintain statistic and other data, and support the outcome system
- Maintain good communication and relation with inter-department staff
- Consult with licensed care managers or licensed supervisor as needed
- Provide services in-person/ in office(s)
- Other duties assigned

Qualifications

- Minimum of a Master degree in Behavioral Health field (Counseling, Psychology or Social Work)
- Minimum of two (2) years of experience in the Behavioral Health field
- Clear driving record and ability to travel between offices
